The Modern Eye Care Health, Science, and Mathematics Scholarship is awarded annually to four well rounded high school seniors in Cabarrus County Schools (public and private). This \$500 scholarship is both need based and merit based. Therefore, the Federal Application for Student Aid (FAFSA) is required to be considered. The minimum eligible G.P.A. requirement is a 3.0. Selections will be based on students' overall academic standing, financial need, extracurricular activities, leadership skills, and participation in community activities. Preference will be given to those who plan to pursue a career involving health, science, and/or mathematics (but not required).

To be considered for scholarships, students must be a U.S. citizen, apply for admission to a College or University, and be a 2010 high school graduate from one of the following schools:

- Jay M Robinson High School
- Cox Mill High School
- Northwest Cabarrus High School
- Cannon School

Application Deadline is **March 15th, 2010**.

All finalists will be personally interviewed during the month of April, 2010.

Those students receiving awards will be notified at the beginning of May, and will be required to pick up their award certificates in person. Actual awards will be forwarded directly to the students' school of choice.
